What's the time commitment?

- Monthly leadership meetings (90 min)
- Occasional emails or short working sessions in between
- Bi-monthly coalition meetings (Aug, Oct, Dec, Feb, Apr, June)
- A 2-year term, with flexibility - many stay longer!

What do members actually do?

- Help set priorities for the coalition and keep the work focused
- Share updates, flag issues, and suggest solutions
- Represent SI COAD in various spaces and help us grow the network
- Offer input on events, trainings, and strategic partnerships
