Action Learning 2026 is a six-month, in-person leadership cohort for director-level nonprofit leaders ready to grow into their next level of impact.

This experience blends peer learning, coaching, and applied practice to strengthen supervision, decision-making, and team leadership, while grounding leaders in reflective practice, values alignment, and sustainable growth.

In this cycle, leaders will focus on:

- Strengthening your leadership identity and decision-making
- Leading and supervising with clarity, consistency, and care
- Building systems that support accountability and collaboration
- Creating healthier team culture with an equity lens
- Translating reflection into real organizational change

This cohort is designed for:

Director-level nonprofit leaders who:

- Oversee programs, departments, operational functions, or cross-team systems.
- Influence internal systems and team culture.
- Are ready to apply learning in real time inside their organization.

Cohort size is limited to 15 participants to ensure depth, trust, and meaningful application.
